

# JOB'S PROFILE

- Job's Piety (1:1b) a man of faith; a good man; fears God, righteous, "blameless and upright."
- Job's fortune (1:3) 7000 sheep, 3000 camels, 500 yoke of oxen, 500 donkeys, large number of servants.

# JOB'S PROFILE

- **Job's Family (1:2) -** 7 sons and 3 daughters (10)
- Job's regular custom (1:4-5) sacrificed burnt offering for his children



2 waves of tragedy

First wave (1:13-19)

7000 sheep gone, 500 oxen/donkeys gone, all children gone!

Second wave (2:7-8)

Boils from head to toe

# What do we see?

- 1) Man's piety cannot guarantee that life will be perfect all the way through (1:1b) (he feared God and shun evil).
- (2) Man's prosperity does not always guarantee security (1:3) (he had great wealth)

# What do we see?

• (3) Man's religion cannot do anything either. We know that Job's regular religious custom didn't (1:4–5)

# Reason for Job's trials

• The confrontation (1:6-11)

"Remove the blessings and he will curse you."

The agreement – (1:12; 2:6)

God gives Satan permission to do anything to all that Job has, but he is not to touch him physically. Satan must spare his life (2:6).

# Reaction to His Trials - (1:20-22) Right view of

#### God

- The Lord gave (v20)
  - Spiritual
  - Physical

• Jn 3:5 - Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

Jn 3:6 - That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

Jn 6:63 - It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and *they* are life.

# Reaction to His Trials - (1:20-22) Right view of

#### God

- The Lord gave (v20)
  - Spiritual
  - Physical

- Gen. 2:7 and the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.
- Job 27:3 As long as my breath is in me,
   And the breath of God in my nostrils,

# Biblical View of Human Life

#### The Lord gives life.

(Psalm 139:13) (v13) For <u>You</u> formed my inward parts; <u>You</u> covered me in my mother's womb. (v15-16) *My frame was not hidden from <u>You</u>, When I was made in secret, And* skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. <u>Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed</u>. And in Your book they all were written, The days fashioned for me, When as yet there were none of them.

# Biblical View of Human Life

- Human life is made in God's image.
- Human life is sacred.
- Human life kicks in in the womb not from birth.
- An unborn fetus is a living human being, including those with deformities.

11 The LORD said to him, "Who gave human beings their mouths? Who makes them deaf or mute? Who gives them sight or makes them blind? Is it not I, the LORD? Exodus 4:11
