QUESTIONS PEOPLE ASK:

- "If God is really "Abba-Father," our "Loving Daddy," how can He allow His children...?"
- "Why does God permit pain and suffering when He could easily end it?"
- "Does God understand my pain and suffering?"
- "Does God even care?"



• JESUS WAS NO STRANGER TO PAIN AND SUFFERING.



- Vs. 1-2 "...nothing in his appearance that we should desire him."
- The Jews were eager for a powerful ruler, but they see no beauty in Jesus, the carpenter of Galilee despite His good works.



Vs. 5- "He was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.."

 Christ's suffering actually is for us, that we might be healed by His wounds.



• UP TO NOW, PEOPLE REFUSE TO ACKNOWLEDGE HIS SACRIFICIAL AND SELFLESS ACT ON OUR BEHALF.



WHEN WE CRY OUT TO CHRIST, HE UNDERSTANDS YOUR PAIN AND SUFFERING BECAUSE HE ENDURED THE SAME. (Isaiah 53:2-13)

• THE BIBLE NEVER SUGGESTS THAT OUR EXPERIENCE OF PAIN AND SUFFERING WILL BE "FAIR."
