Isaiah 40:25-31

“Holy” means

- “separate”
- “cut-off”

Comes from Hebrew word
“qadowsh” = a word to
describe something
(object/act or someone
(person))



“Holy One”

A title that describes the “otherness” nature of God, His transcendence, His separateness from all that He has made.





God is present in His creation but He is distinct and separate from all creation.

v25) “to whom will you compare ? Or “who is my equal?”



PANTHEISM - a belief that God is found everywhere in nature; that the universe or nature conceived as a whole is God; that God is not separate from creation but is in creation.

PROMOTES THE WORSHIP AND TOLERANCE OF MANY GODS



God is distinct and separate from creation but is not detached or indifferent from His creation. This clashes with **deistic** view of God.

v26) Lift up your eyes to the sky and see for yourself. Who do you think created the cosmos?



DEISM - a belief that God created the universe but then He left people to take care of and provide for themselves without depending on anyone else including God.

“THE WORLD DOESN’T NEED GOD OR A GOD”



V28) “do you not know? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the creator of the ends of the earth.”



“WAIT” – figuratively is “to expect,” “to look,” “wait for,” “gather”

- **Straining of the mind in a certain direction with an expectant attitude**
- **A forward look with assurance**



The other dimension of God's holiness is His moral, ethical holiness.

Leviticus 19:2 "You shall be holy; for I the Lord your God am holy."



In New Testament, believers are designated as ekklesia – “saints” or “holy ones, the “elect”, the “called,” the “beloved”

A people set apart for God’s own purposes – holy in God’s sight

God commands that they progress in holiness.



WHAT IS GOD SAYING TODAY?

1. that He is the Holy One of Israel. He is separate from His creation but not distant from His creation.
2. That He can help you live a holy life by the Spirit of God.



WHAT DOES THE HOLY ONE COMMAND THAT YOU DO FROM TODAY?

1. Return to God.
2. Replenish your strength.
3. Revive your faith.
4. Rekindle your passion.
