- v3) "This is good and pleases the Savior; "peace and quiet lives" v4) Salvation
- The basis for prayer is the sacrificial work of Jesus Christ as Savior, Ransom, and Mediator (v5).
- The word "ransom" is ""antilutron" in Greek, meaning in substitution for the slave or prisoner.


