What does the love of Christ mean?

- **Sinner pardoned (8:31-32)**
- **Charges dropped;
condemned no more
(8:1, 33-34)**
- **Peace with God (5:1-11)**



The love of Christ gave me a whole new life (v37).

- **Sinner to saint/dead to sin, alive in Christ (6:1-11).**
- **Unrighteous to righteous (3:21-26)**
- **Slaves to sons (8:14-16)**



The love of Christ does not excuse us from struggles.

ROMANS 7:18, CEB

I know that good doesn't live in me—that is, in my body. The desire to do good is inside of me, but I can't do it.

ROMANS 8:35, CEB

Who will separate us from Christ's love? Will we be separated by trouble, or distress, or harassment, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?



The love of Christ is the source of our overcoming conquering spirit (8:37).

- Shall you go on sinning so that grace may increase? (6:17-18)
- “You can’t but He can.” (8:11, 15-17)
- “ You share in His suffering as well as in His glory (8:28-30).
- “It’s all good (8:28-29)
- “You have a responsibility not to your flesh but the Spirit.”
