God's Complaint Against the Remnants



HAGGAI 1:9-11

9 “You expected much, but see, it turned out to be little. What you brought home, I blew away. Why? Declares the Lord Almighty. “Because of my house, which remains a ruin, while each of you is busy with your own house.

10 Therefore, because of you the heavens withheld their dew and the earth its crops.

11 I called for a drought on the fields and the mountains, on the grain, the new wine, the olive oil and everything else the ground produces, on people and livestock, and on all the labour of your hands.”

God's Mandate to the Remnants



- To build the house of the Lord
(Haggai 1:7; 2 Chronicles 36:22-23; Ezra 1:1-5)

This is what the Lord Almighty says: “Give careful thought to your ways. Go up into the mountains and bring down timber and build my house, so that I may take pleasure in it and be honored,” says the Lord. You expected much, but see, it turned out to be little.



God said:

- 1. Be strong - 3x (2:4)**
- 2. Do not fear - (2:5)**
- 3. Work - (2:4)**



God's Assurance:

- **Power** - "I will once more shake the heavens and the earth, the sea, and the dry land." (2:6-7)
- **Provision** - "The silver is mine and the gold is mine." (2:8)
- **Peace** - "In this place I will grant peace." (2:9)



God's Assurance:

- **Presence -**
 - "For I am with you." (2:4)
 - "I will fill this house with glory". (2:7)
 - "The glory of this house will be greater than the glory of the former house." (2:9)
