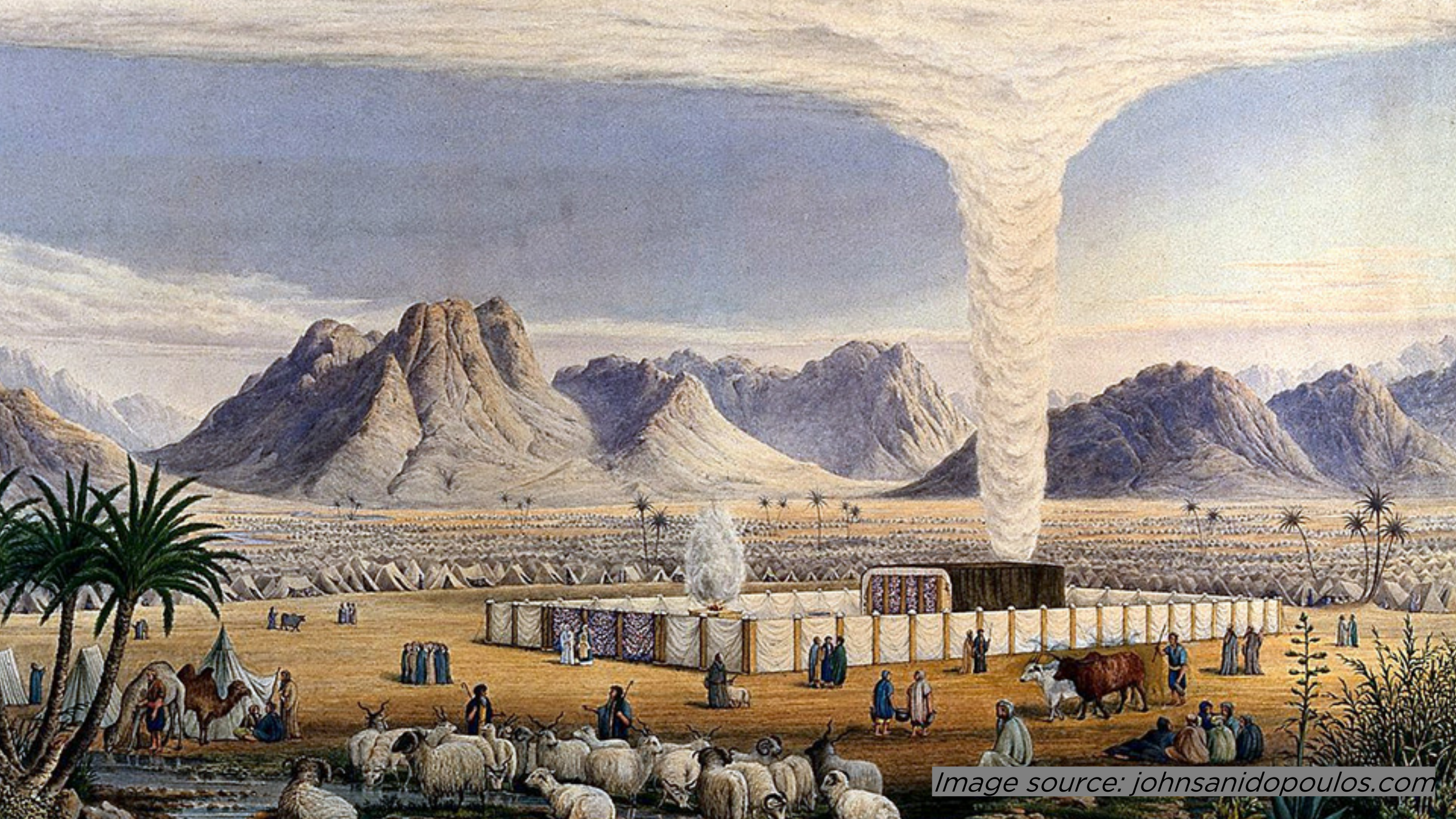

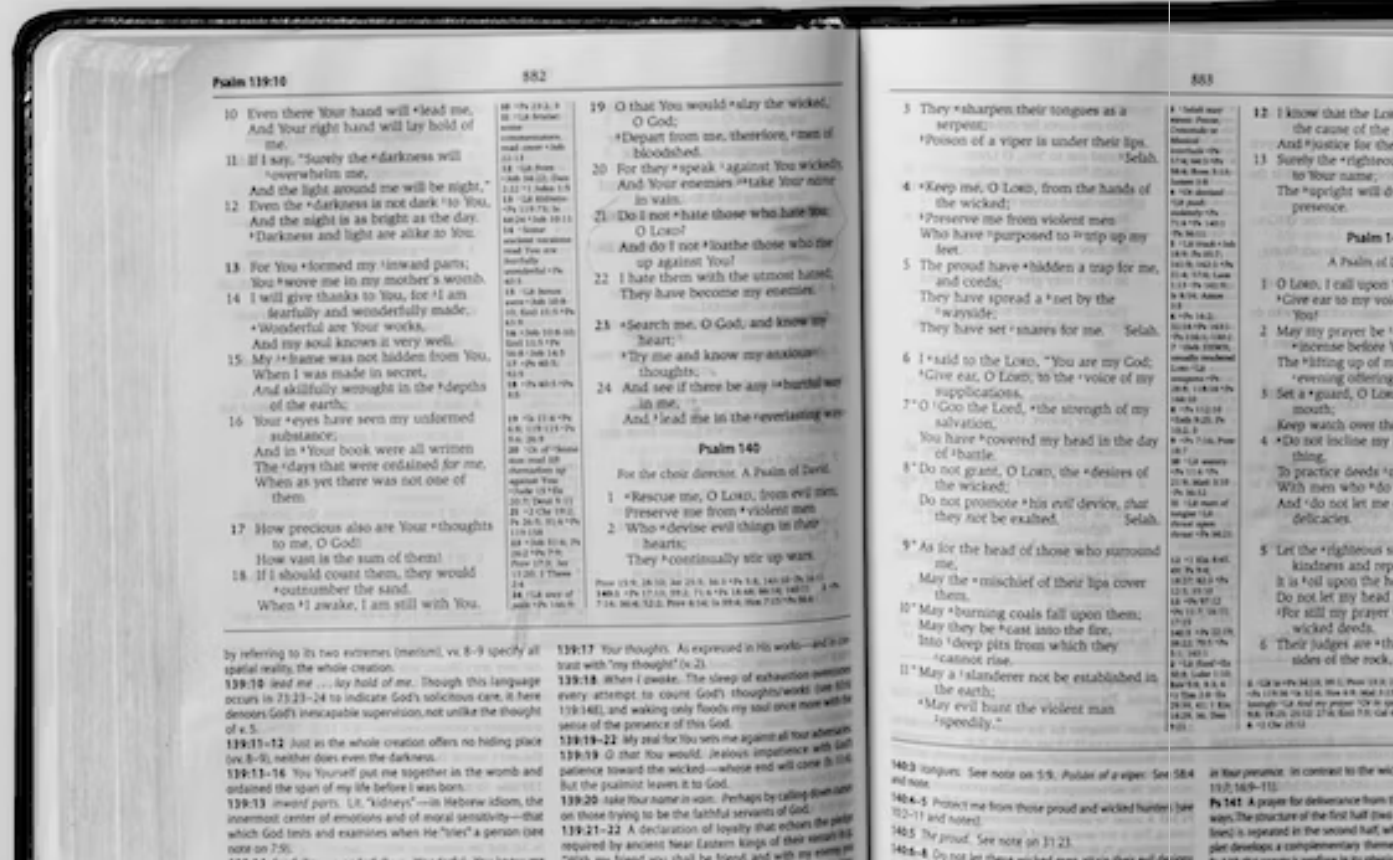

139:10 and me ... lay hold of me. Though this language occurs in 75:23-24 to indicate God's solicitous care, it here denotes God's inescapable supervision, not unlike the thought of x.5.
139:11-12 Just as the whole creation offers no hiding place (vs. 8-9), neither does even the darkness.
139:13-14 You Yourself put me together in the womb and ordained the span of my life before I was born.
139:13 inward parts. Lit. "kidneys"—in Hebrew idiom, the innermost center of emotions and of moral sensitivity—that which God tests and examines when He "tries" a person (see note on 7:5).

139:17 Your thoughts. As expressed in His words—and in contrast with "my thought" (v.2).
139:18 When I awake. The sleep of exhaustion overcomes every attempt to count God's thoughts/works (see 139:14b), and waking only floods my soul once more with the sense of the presence of this God.
139:19-22 My soul for You sets me apart all Your adversary.
139:19 O that You would. Jealous impatience with God's patience toward the wicked—whose end will come (v.10). But the psalmist leaves it to God.
139:20 take Your name in vain. Perhaps by calling down upon on those trying to be the faithful servants of God.
139:21-22 A declaration of loyalty that echoes the pledge required by ancient Near Eastern kings of their vassals (139:21), and, indeed, you shall be found, and with my eyes on you.

140:3 serpents. See note on 5:5. Poisons of a viper. See note on 132:11 and notes.
140:4-5 Protect me from their proud and wicked hunter (see note on 131:2).
140:5 the proud. See note on 31:23.
140:6-8 Do not let these wicked men rejoice over my distress.

140:9 in their presence. In contrast to the wicked (132:18-19).
Ps 141. A prayer for deliverance from the ways. The structure of the first half (lines 1-5) is separated in the second half, which develops a complementary theme.
