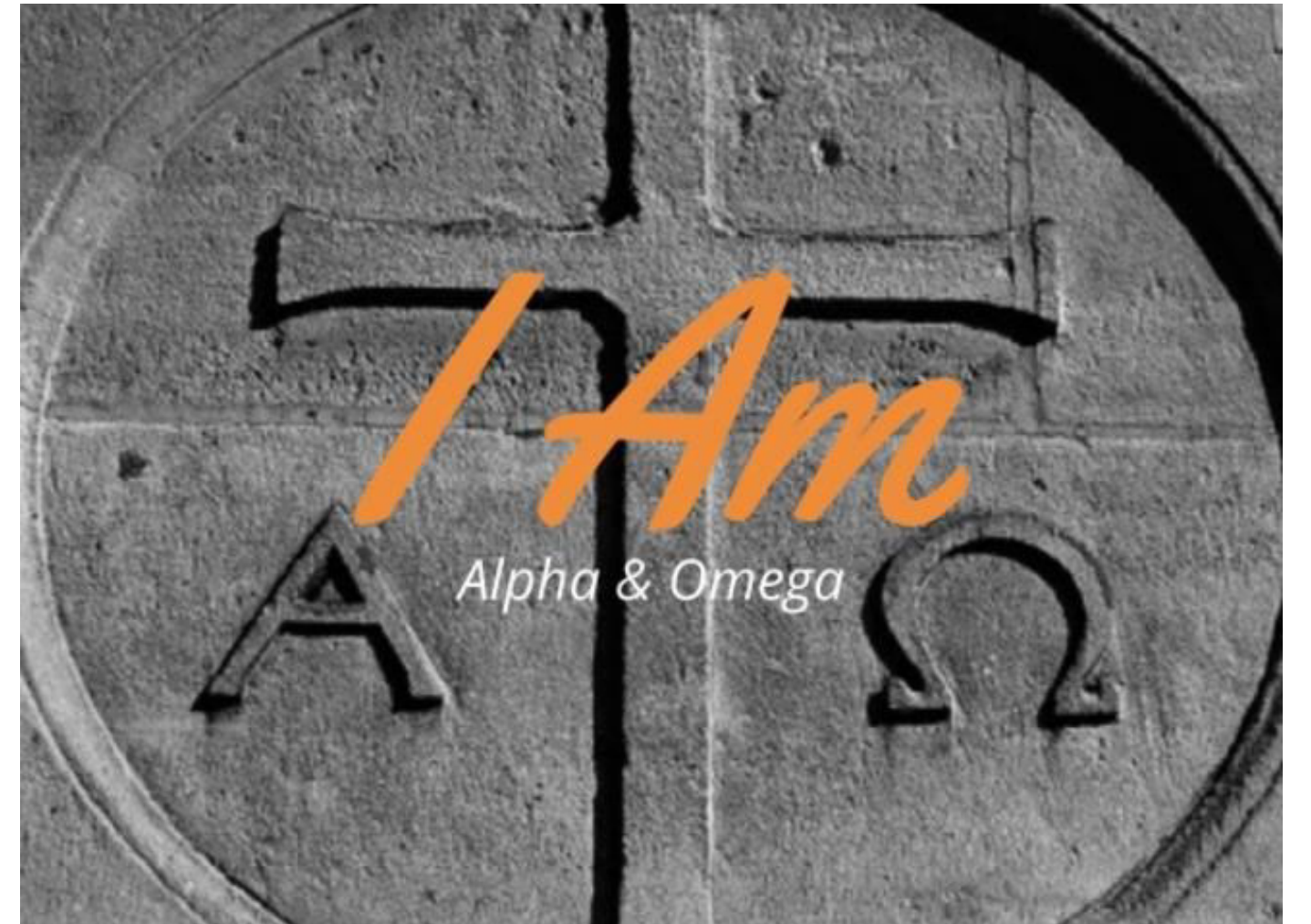
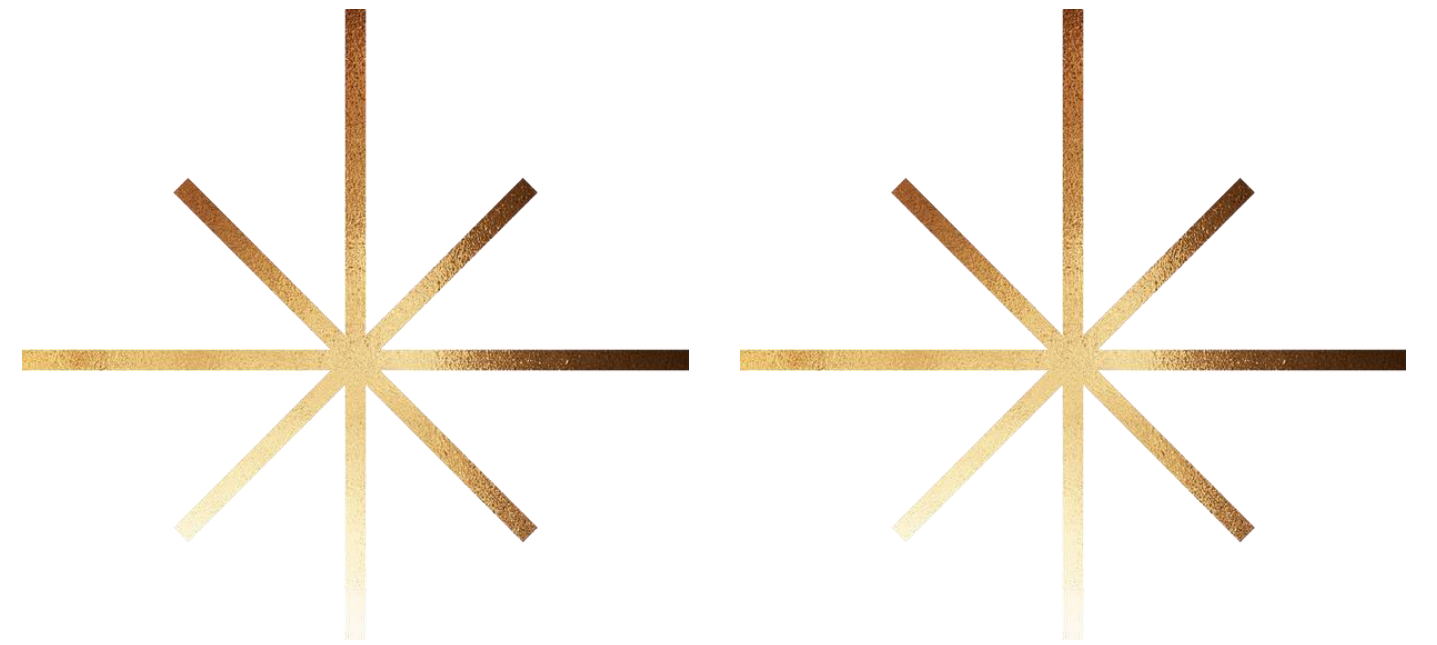

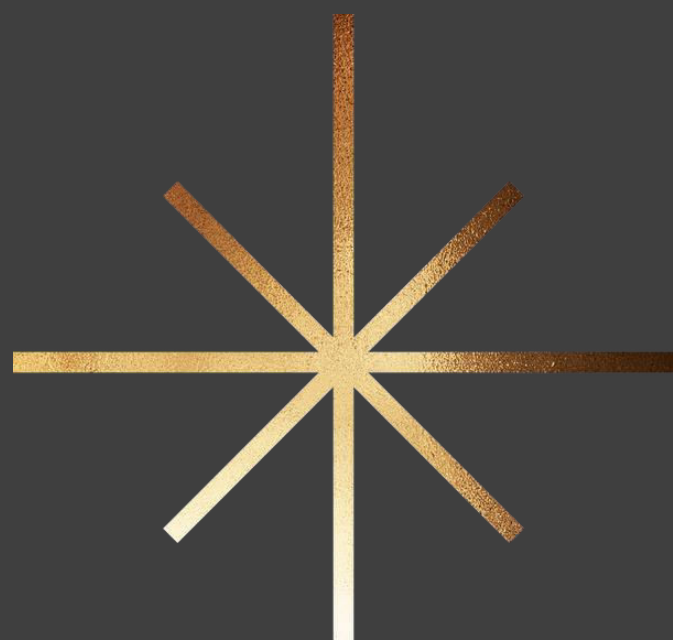
For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.



JOHN 8:30

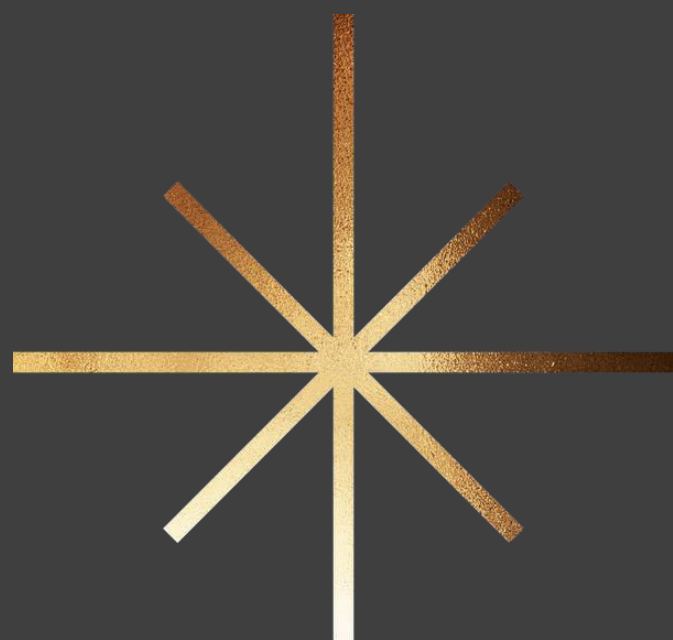

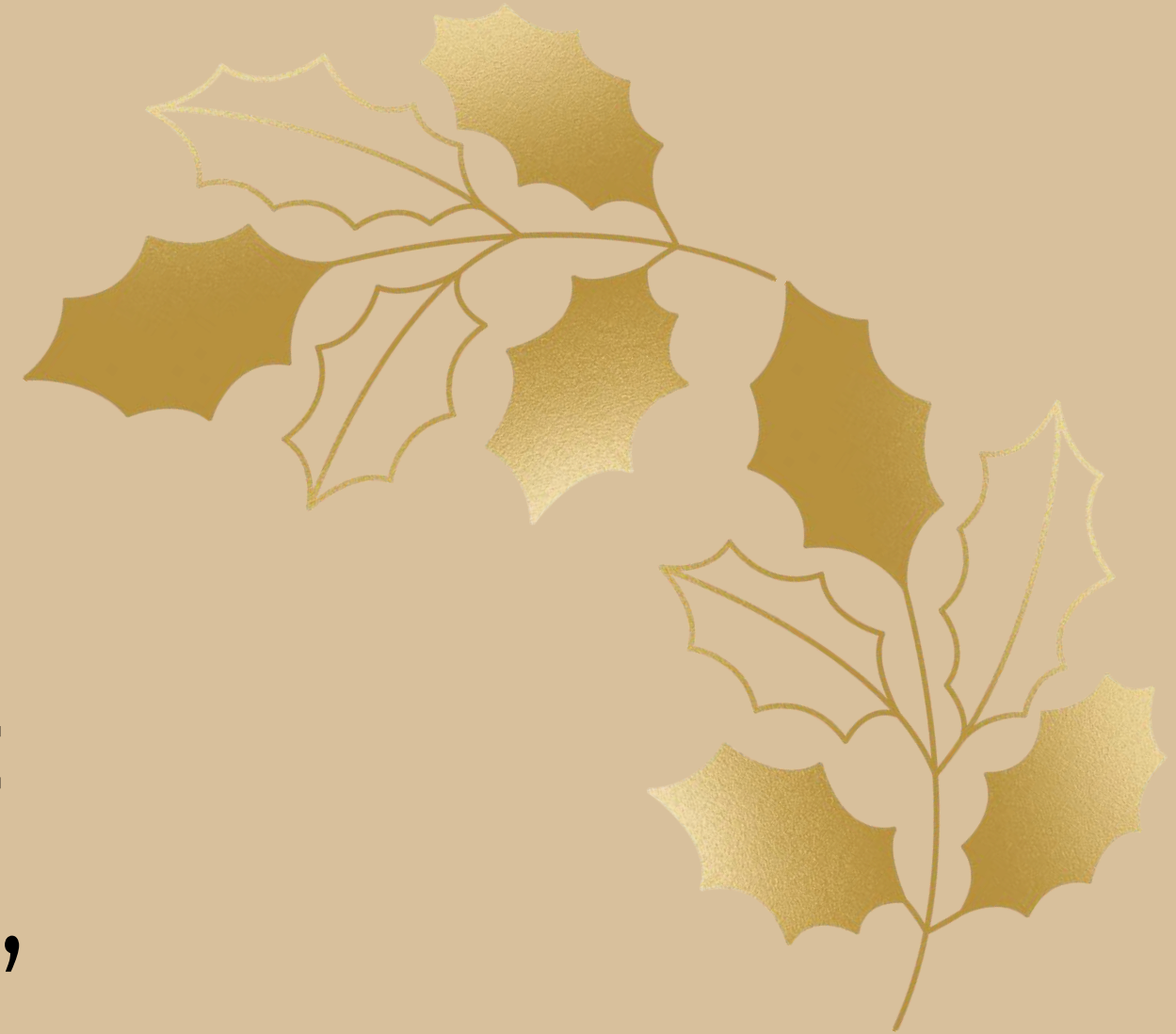
1 John 3:8

“The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The blessings from our Lord Jesus Christ be upon you.”



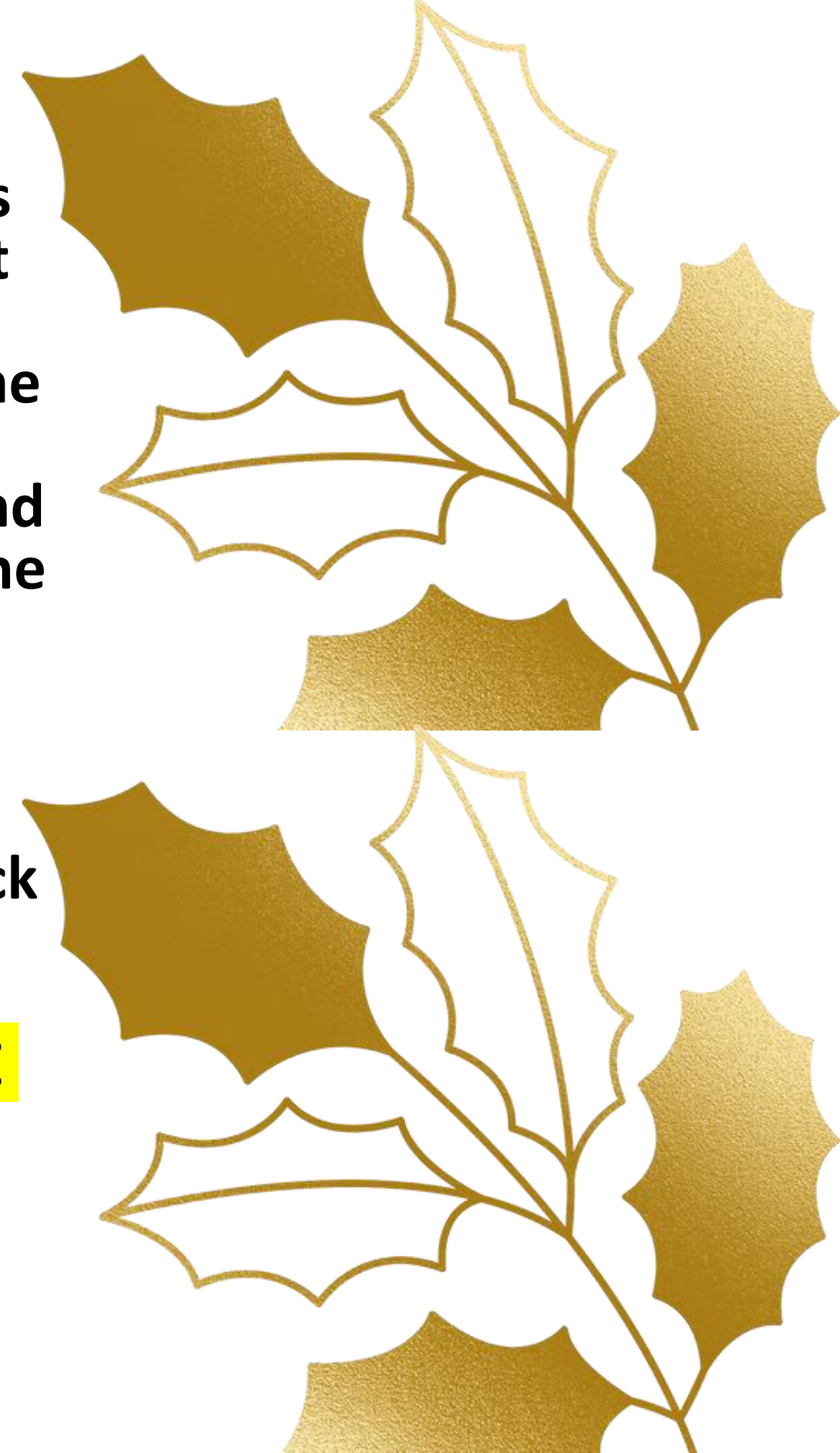
Philippians 4:7

- **“And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”**



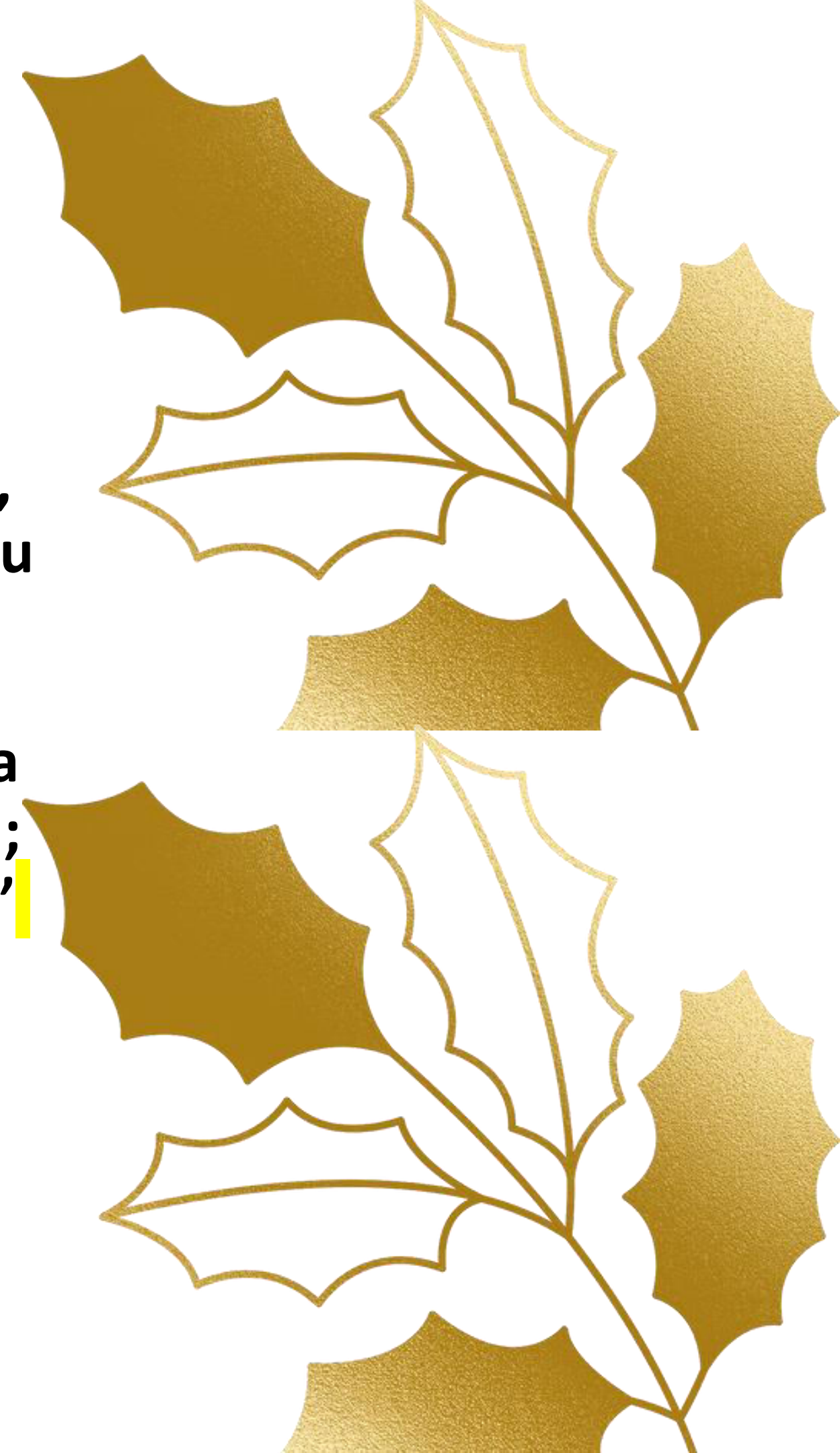
Matthew 12:17-21
