I. One would only seek the path to God if they truly believe in His existence and in a place where He dwells. (verses 1-5).




- Jesus promised His disciples, "I am going there to prepare a place for you," and

II. God the Father provided a sure and only way to get to Him! (v6).




- Jesus' claim as the only Way, Truth, and Life spares humans from guessing how to get to the Father.

- As the Life, He gives our dead spirit a new life.




