18 Early in the morning, as Jesus was on his way back to the city, he was hungry.

19 Seeing a fig tree by the road, he went up to it but found nothing on it except leaves. Then he said to it, "May you never bear fruit again!" Immediately the tree withered.

20 When the disciples saw this, they were amazed. "How did the fig tree wither so quickly?" they asked.

21 Jesus replied, "Truly I tell you, if you have faith and do not doubt, not only can you do what was done to the fig tree, but also you can say to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and it will be done.

Passover)


John 12:1 Zechariah 9:9 Jesus was

The next day, the disciples saw that the fig tree withered from its roots




The Fig Tree

A mark of a true follower of Christ is always in the FRUIT

5" I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. 6 If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. 7 If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

8 This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples..."



John 15:5-8

A mark of a true follower of Christ is always in the FRUIT

16 "By their fruit you will recognize them...

17 Likewise, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit.

18 A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit.

19 Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

20 Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them.



Matthew 7:16-20

Jesus cleanses the templeaddressing their religious spirit



a. Worship the Lord with your heart, and not just with your lips

Matthew 15:8 - "These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me"

b. Obedience is better than sacrifice

1 Samuel 15:22 - "But Samuel replied: "Does the Lord delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the Lord? To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams"

c. Spiritual blindness - John 9
