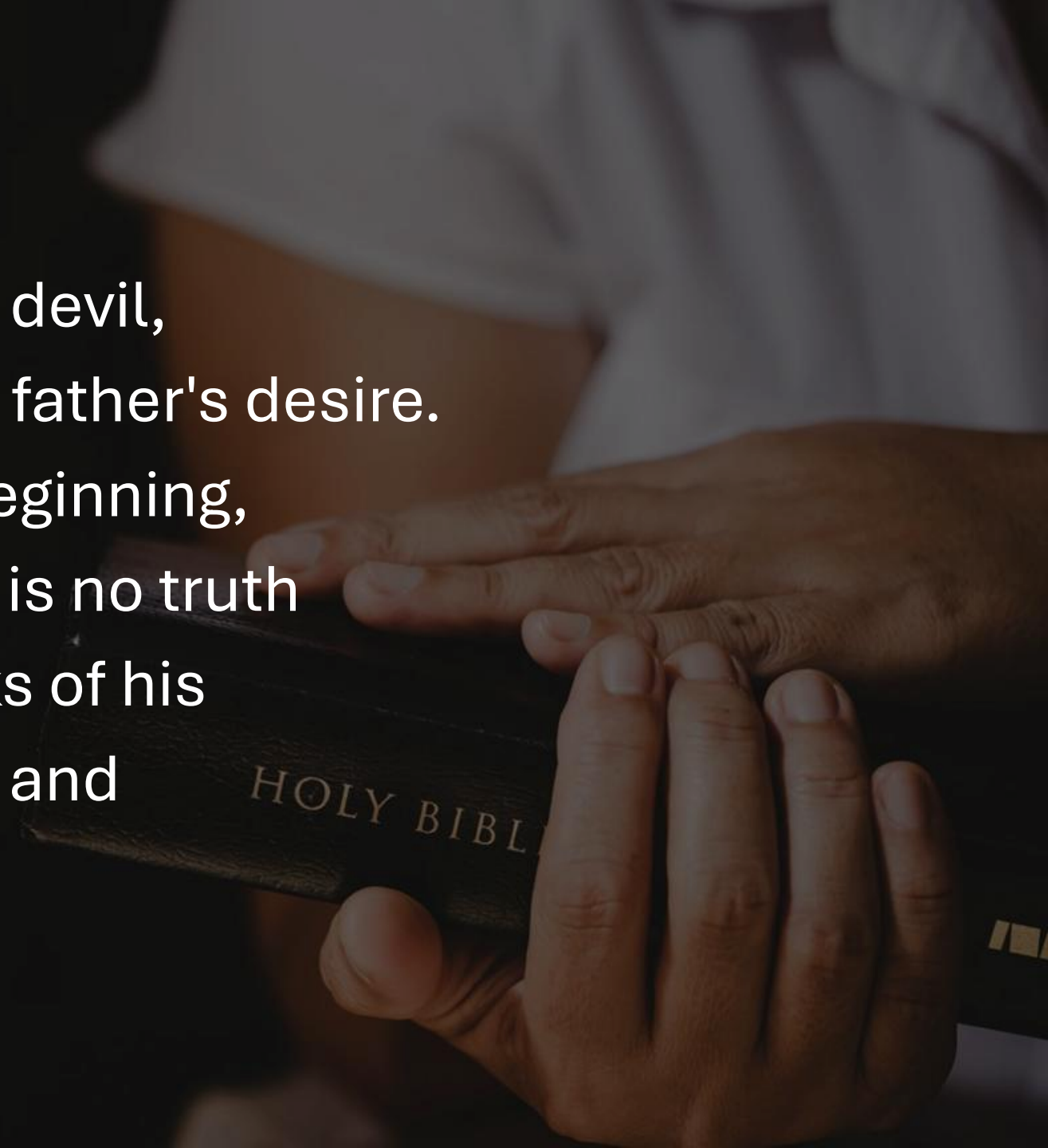
The CLG Pledge

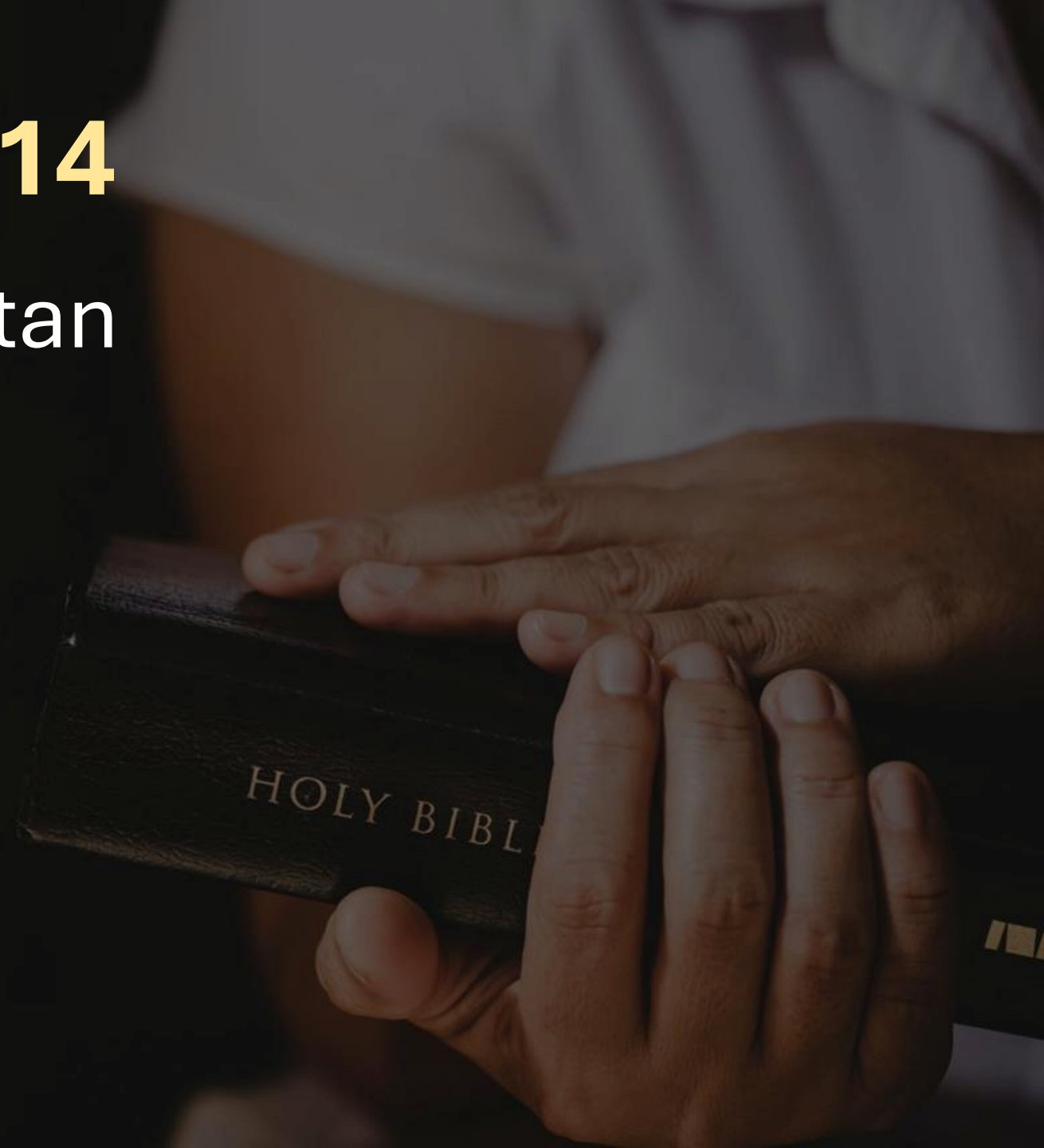

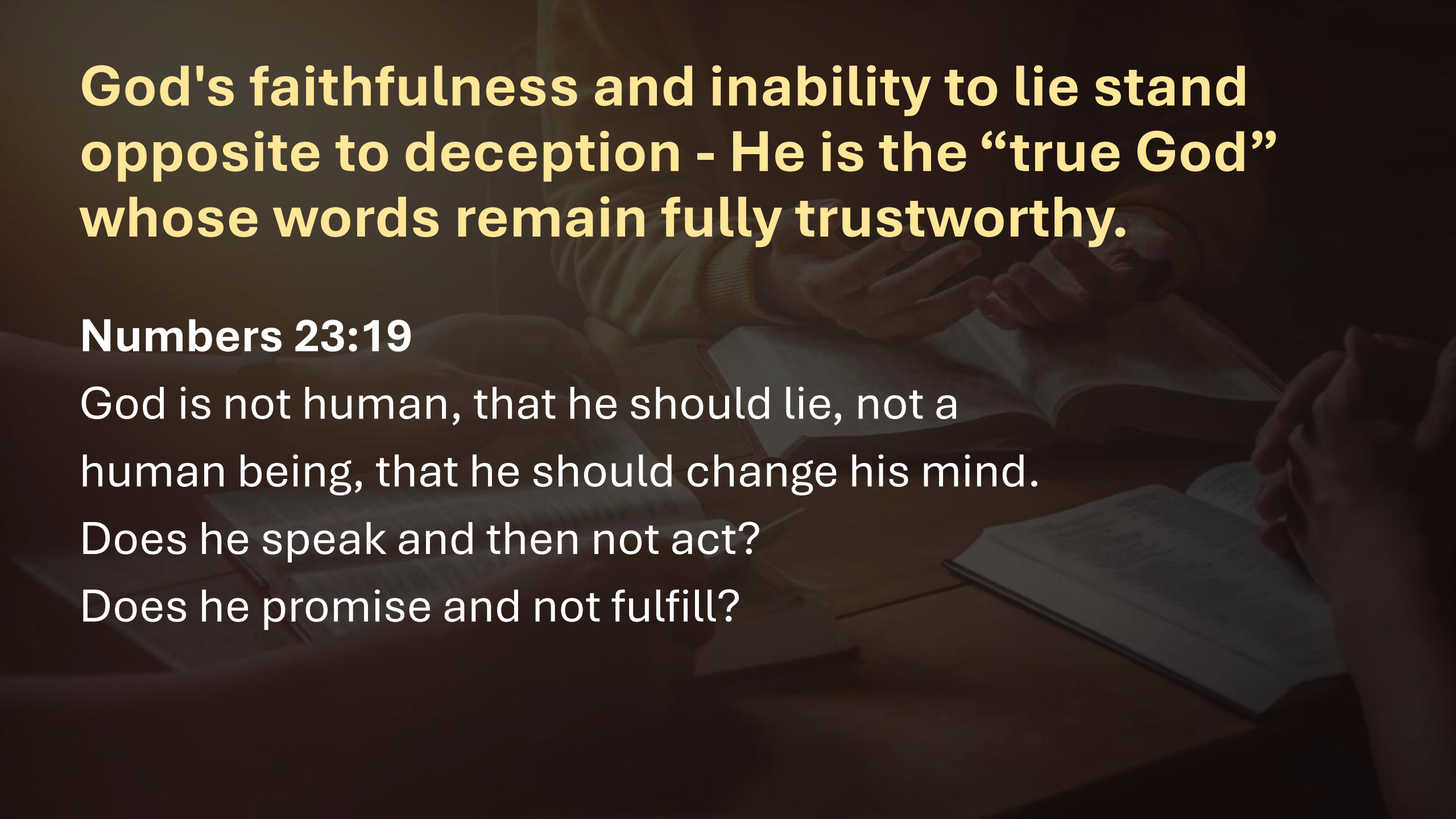


Understanding the devil's nature equips Christ's followers for spiritual warfare.

Does he speak and then not act?

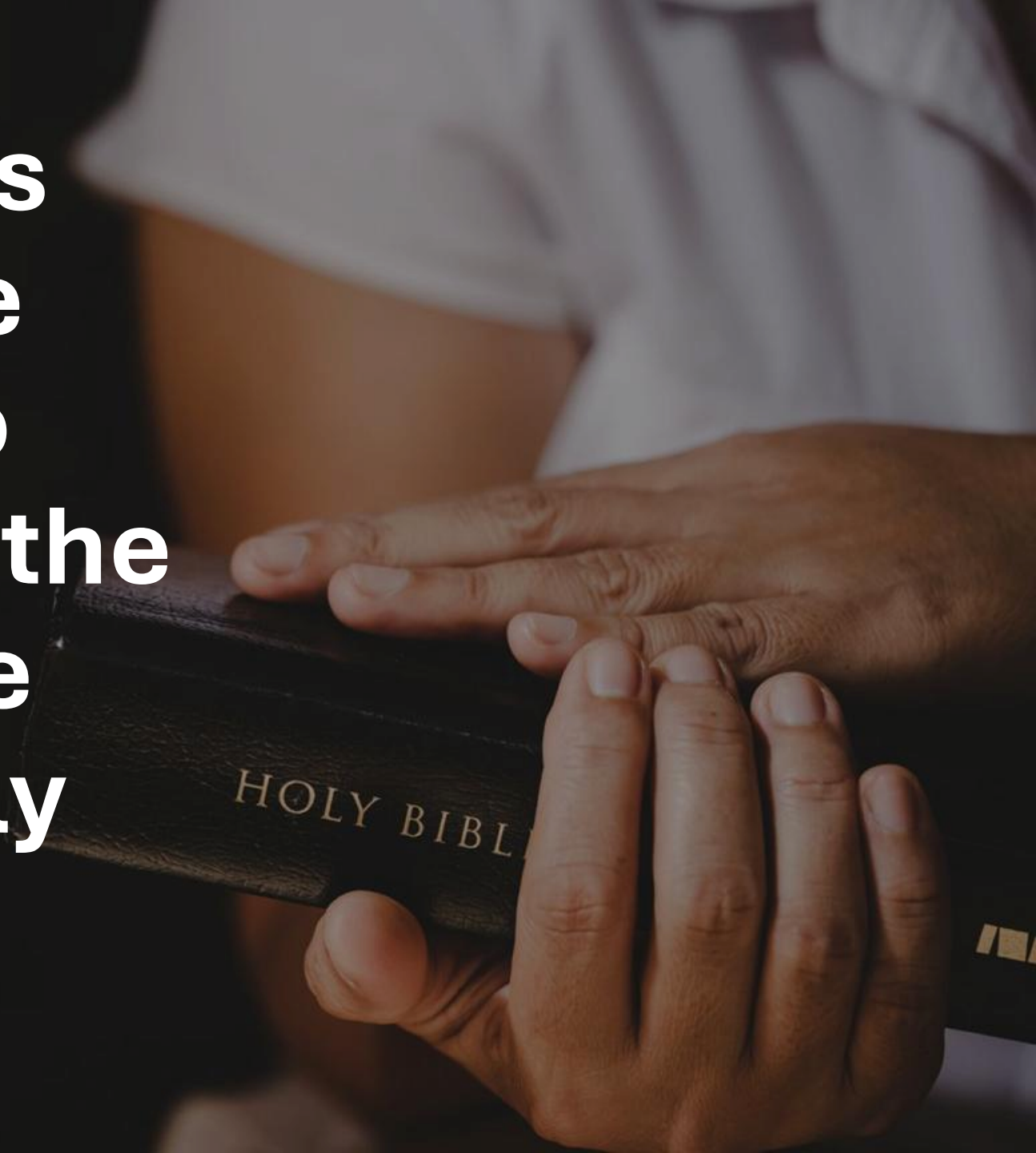
Does he promise and not fulfill?

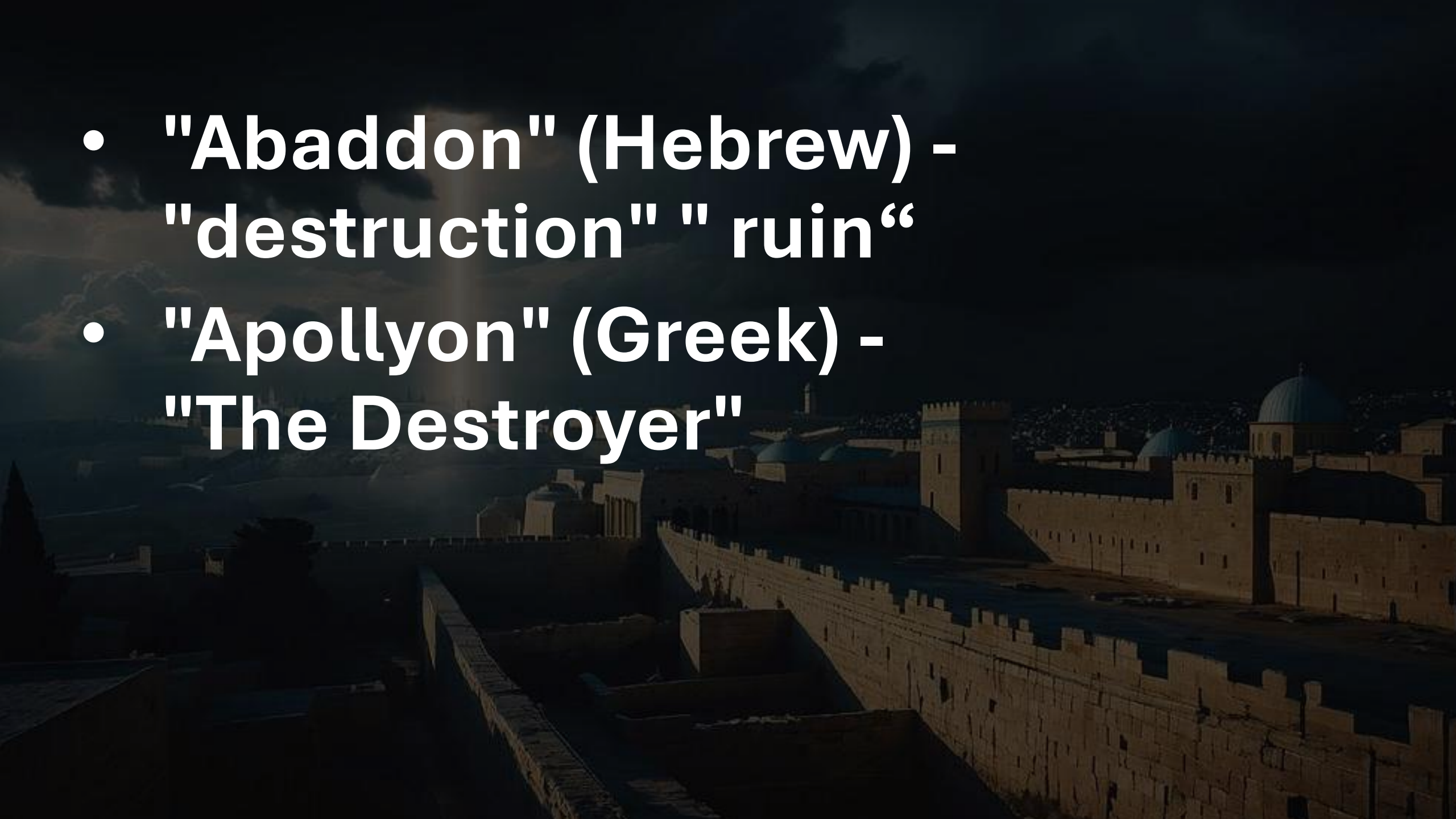
